We ask that you work with us to stop the spread of COVID-19.

Here's what to expect—and what's expected of you—during your time in the Gunnison Valley:

MASK MANDATE

In Gunnison County, face coverings are required for anyone 2 and older in indoor public spaces, or outdoors where social distancing measures can't be met. In Crested Butte, on Elk Ave from 1st to 6th street and adjacent alleys, pedestrians are required to wear masks.




SOCIAL DISTANCING

Our brick and mortar businesses have implemented distancing protocols to guide your experience. In general, please maintain 6 feet of distance between yourself and people who don't live in your household. If outdoors and 6 feet of physical distancing can not be maintained, please wear a face covering.



HAND WASHING & HEIGHTENED HYGIENE

Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds—especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. Use a hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are unavailable.
