We have inventory in Gunnison.

Mountain Manners

- Crested Butte Chamber reported that visitor numbers were down (Chamber counts heads, so it's not the most reliable reporting).
- Reaman said things didn't seem less busy as did lodges and businesses.
- We don't yet have an official report for visitor #s.
- Stone Mt Crested Butte is not as max'd out as people would think over the holiday.
- Gunnison 4th of July extremely busy in Gunny but some businesses were closed on Sunday and Monday.
- Gunnison paper featured an article about restaurants having problems staffing this summer
 - Less staff/over-worked staff can lead to poor customer service.
- Pierson will look into university students leading acustomer service training exercise.

Mt. Crested Butte Tax Admission Grants

- The TA will request approximately \$250k for winter marketing.
 - o Air Command/Air Alliance/RTA/CBMR support this request.

ONE GOOD RIDE MTB Series—Runcie

- Hartman Rocks Ridge Trail Episodepre-roll debuted on Teton Gravity Research.
- Buttery shot 9 additional trails before July 4.
- Sharing these predominantly via social.

Ski Report—Clarkson

- 53.9m skiers in U.S. last season (+26%)
- CBMR unit sales grew
 - o Feb + March were up for CBMR this year.
- Snowboarding is on a gradual down trend.
 - CBMR and Burton will meet about improving the boarding experience and make it more accessible.
- Colorado Ski Country saw7.4M ski visits this year.
- New record this year with 13M visits = Colorado Ski Country + Vail

Google Search Volume—Kreykes

- We lead our competitive set in fat biking, fishing, wildflowers and Nordic searches.
- Analyzing search volume helps us target our blog posts and other content.
- Data: May 2015 May 2016 compared to May 2014 2015.
- Key Search Volume: we're beat out by Whistler, Park City, and Moab. We're on par with Fruita and seem to be edging them out.

Guest Research Project—Runcie

- Visitors give their contact info, answer questions (where they're from, what brought them here, activities etc.).
- Survey spots are Snodgrass, CB, Gunnison.
- Runcie will send survey to board.

Gunnison Main St. Project – Morrison

- Revisions to the original plan are in orderbecause some Tomichi businesses are concerned about accessibility.
- Reducing the width of Gunnison road lanes down to the national average has been approved.
- Applications for state funding are due the end of July.
 - o Projects include bike lanes, entry features, reducing width of road lanes.
