1. Roll Call-We have a quorum.

- 2. Approval of September Minutes-Approved
- 3. Public's Comments
 - a. Tim Kugler, Gunnison Trails-Approval from BLM to groom up to 25 miles at Hartman Rocks. Looking at realistically about 13 miles. Will be kind of a learning curve. All 4 shops are doing rental bikes in Gunnison. Tim and Gunnison Trails are asking the TA for help with the purchase of the groomer.
 - b. Signal Peak, EIS is getting pushed back to a later date. The Keystone group is on board with Signal Peak and prepared to put out support in favor.
- Destimetrics Septemer #4 of 19 valleys in occupancy at 60%.
 September Occupancy growth #4 of 19 with 7% increase
 September rate growth +2% ranked 17 of 19.
 Jan 18 +35% vs previous year.
- 5. Mountain Biking
 - a. Ken Stone's our previous board member reported shuttle companies at most of the bike destinations that he is visiting. We are in a good position, let's not lose sight of the importance of trails.
 - b. Outerbike goes to Bentonville which is another example of how we are on the right course with Mountain Bike.
- 6. Air report
 - a. Outbound air promotion-68% sold of the 50k.
 - b. Inbound air promotion-2% sold of 150k.

- c. Denver January flight is on pace to fill seats. Doubled occupancy and we more than doubled the seats that we have sold. We plan to build urgency with a book by date for our inbound air promotions.
- d. Montrose/Telluride has added Charlotte, NC
- e. Scott Clarkson concerned about the early December Dallas. What can we do to fill those seats? Maybe using some outbound \$'s for that December 15-21. We are training the airlines to add flights during bad times.
- 7. Crested Butte Mountain hits #14 in SkiMag ratings
 Ski Mag sends out to the database and asks customers to rank resorts on various categories. This year they moved to 10 categories instead of about 20.
- 8. PR Report
 - a. Add value down YOY compared to September 2016. Main reason is because of New York Times Article on the MAX pass last year.
 - b. Duane Vandenbusche a good candidate for a story. WSJ has run a number of articles about staying active into old age. Andrew to follow up with Duane.
- 9. Gunnison Lodging Update
 - a. We are still working to get enough involvement from Destimetrics. Michele at Quality Inn has started a Lodging group in Gunnison. We plan to try and get involved to build participation from Gunnison properties.
